IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

Building Repainting proposal was approved. A meeting is scheduled for April 18 with the painting contractor and paint manufacturer. 
Plans continue for a third garage building in the G Building parking lot.

A large majority of our owners who voted recently were in favor of changing our Condominium Declarations, but only 48% of our owners voted – not enough for any changes to be adopted.
