Budget Strategy and Mission for Lakeside

Pool, Clubhouse and Gym Closure

Unfortunately, we discovered that our facilities were being exploited by non-residents and sometimes aided by lakeside owners.

The BOD, in an abundance of caution and consistent with the neighboring facilities, closed the pool, clubhouse and gym to protect our owners from infections.

Sanitation of our Common Area's

For two weeks now, our Janitorial staff has been cleaning and disinfecting our common areas twice a day on weekdays.



As to date, Daniel Dodge (our newest hired custodian/maintenance man) has completed all three levels of the buildings. Daniel cleaned, scraped, bleached, and painted the ledges.

The next process will be the fourth & fifth floor levels, which are performed from the inside of the patios.

The removal of the lower panel screens will be needed to complete the four-step procedure and then reinstallation of the screen panels.

The office will be contacting the fourth & fifth floor owners to schedule interior access.
