At a high level, we achieved many tasks in 2024:

- passed our Structural Integrity Study (with minor repairs) with the comment that structures have 35 more years of usefulness.
 - Made a number of Structural repairs.
 - received a positive review of our Reserves with a "strong" rating.
 - tree trimming and removing nuts on Mahogany trees damaging vehicles.
- annual roof maintenance to secure insurance coverage beyond acceptable 20—year roof life.
- installed interior elevator tiles & new elevator boards to meet fire safety requirements.
 - installed required Door Lock Monitors to assure safe elevator door closure.
- major pool/spa leak repairs & re-grounding of electrical connectivity to ensure pool safety.
 - flower planting project to achieve cost savings.
 - completed building valuations each averaging \$11,400,000.00.
 - strengthened Rules and Regulations.
 - fountain mooring repairs and annual fire sprinkler testing.

In the interest of full transparency, all the above listed items, along with the Board of Directors Minutes, Treasurers Reports, Monthly Financials, Insurance schedules, etc. are available to review on our website. In the upcoming new year, you will see more social events and opportunities to meet your neighbors. This will be proactive to improve safety on our property. 
Annually maintain and inspect your air conditioning handler to avoid leaks into units below!
