NO OILS DOWN THE DRAINS

Please Do Not pour any kind of oils down the sink drains, this would include fatty oils from meat products!

Oil and grease solidify & cling to the walls of your pipes when it cools. Over time, the solidified fats accumulate & form blockages restricting water flow.

The grease acts as a magnet for other debris, like food particles and soap scum, worsening the blockage!

Toilet Leaks: Toilet leaks can waste large amounts of water. Check for water stains, warped flooring, or a constantly running toilet.



Appliance Leaks: Appliances such as dishwashers, refrigerator lines, and washing machines can leak.
